- Yes, there are a lot of differences. People are not walking from home, jobs are scarce so people lose their jobs, and I can see adult education are studied from distance online. And in the bus people try to be conscious about what they do, people they sit close to, and I am sure, if anybody is in a seat nobody wants to go close to that seat. So that's how it is since Corona came.

- And are you moving in different spaces, are you avoiding certain spaces? Or have you discovered any new ones that you like to go to?
- For sure, I try to be careful with where I go, and yes, I avoid crowded places especially. But I always have my normal routines.
